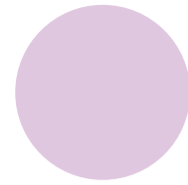


HHHHMM Quality of Life Scale

However, there is a measure we can refer to assess the animal's quality of life. The "HHHHMM" Quality of Live Scale by **Dr. Alice Villalobos**.





The purpose of the scale is to help owners measure their pet's quality of life, often at a time where their emotions are particularly raw, with the support of a veterinary professional.

By scoring each criterion on a scale of 1-10, a total score of 35 or more indicates an acceptable quality of life.

However, there will be occasions where the pet's suffering is obvious, and a quick decision is needed to protect the animal's welfare. In these instances, the Vet is best placed to advise on the most appropriate course of action.
